Benefits of this training

Participants experience a full lifecycle of a complex project over three days through an immersive case study. The course enables participants to:

- Understand the key drivers of project governance and project control
- Develop a cross-functional understanding of project management processes, including complexity management, project structuring (WBS), scheduling, cost management, risk management, and reporting to senior management
- Analyze project data and anticipate potential issues before
- Strengthen their ability to maintain control and deliver successful projects

All phases of the project lifecycle are covered throughout the three-day program.

Learning objectives

Through team-based practical exercises, participants will acquire the best practices required to successfully control and manage complex projects:

- Structure a project effectively.
- Understand the key drivers of project performance.
- Manage performance, cost, and schedule in a balanced and consistent manner.
- Identify warning signs and sources of complexity and develop appropriate action plans.
- Establish a collaborative approach to Project Management.
- Share lessons learned and practical experience with peers

Teaching approaches

The training combines theoretical sessions (approximately 20%) with practical application workshops (approximately 80%) conducted in small teams using a comprehensive complex-project case study.

Participants practice proven Project Management methods and techniques using tools and templates that can be directly applied to their day-to-day professional activities.

- Experienced Project Managers currently responsible for, or preparing to take responsibility for, a Level C project.
- Members of project teams with 2 to 5 years of professional experience.
- Professionals wishing to structure their approach to Project Management, enhance their practices, or acquire both the theoretical foundations and practical skills required to manage projects effectively.

Project Planning

- Manage project schedules and deadlines

- Develop the project budget
- Identify and manage optimization opportunities
- Support decision-making through Value Analysis

Managing Project Risks and Opportunities

- Identify project risks and their root causes
- Assess risk severity and potential impacts

Monitoring and Controlling Project Performance

- Analyse project progress and performance
- Prepare project status reports
- Present executive summaries and project updates to the Project Steering Committee

- Capture and capitalize on lessons learned
- Conduct a Lessons Learned Review
